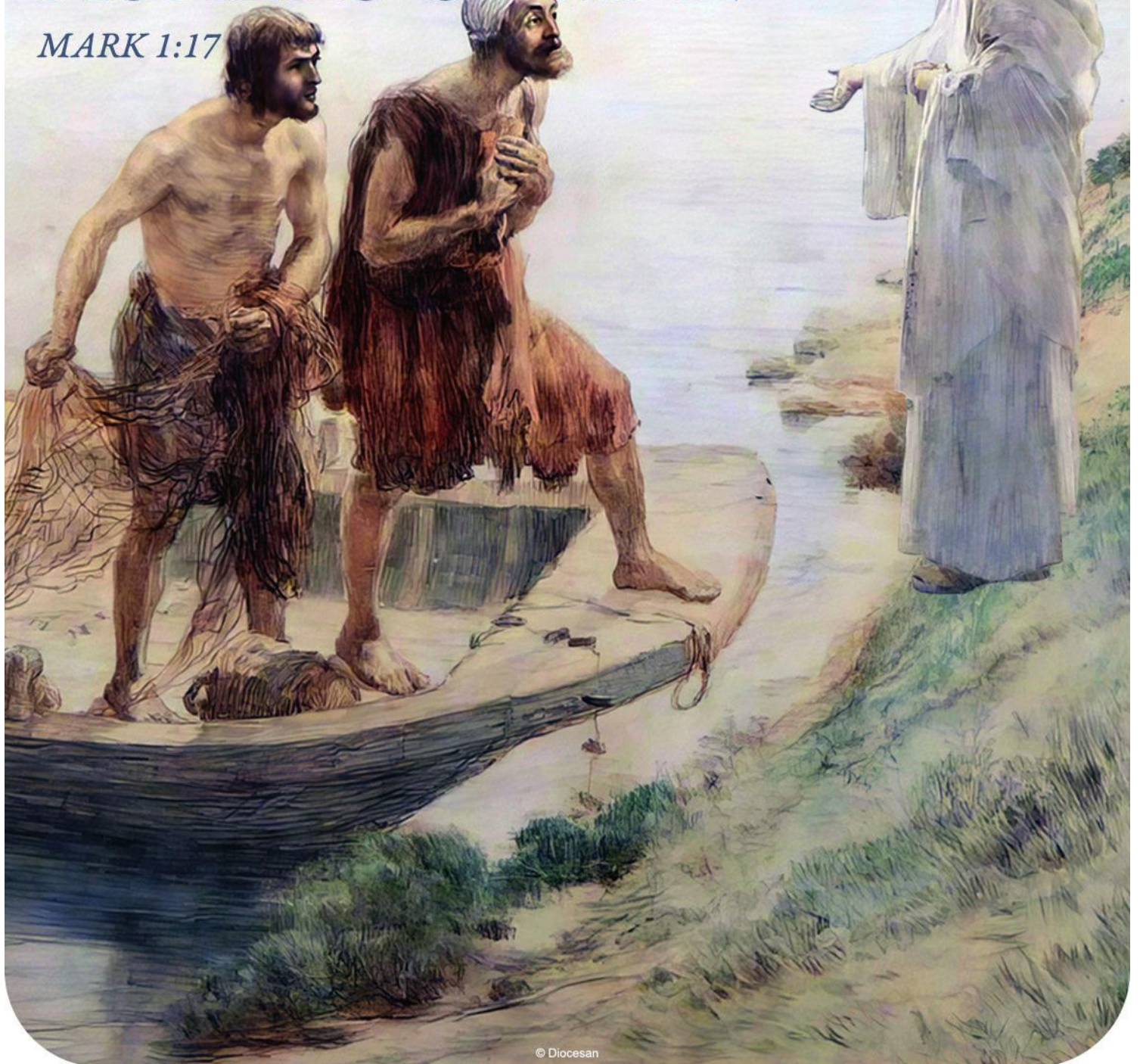

WORSHIPING IMAGES?

Some non-Catholics accuse Catholics of worshiping statues, citing passages in the Bible that prohibit the making of images and bowing down to them. They are referring primarily to the Catholic practice of having statues of Jesus, Mary, Joseph and saints in our churches and in our homes.

The Bible has many passages where God instructs the Jewish people to make images of angels for the temple. At a time when the Jewish people were attacked by serpents, God told Moses in the Book of Numbers to mount a statue of a serpent on a pole. Those who were bitten by actual serpents had to look at the image on the pole in order to be healed.

Catholics don't worship statues and other images. They are used to help us recall the lives of those who are portrayed by statues, just like having a picture of a family member. Images can also be used for instruction. Even the words and pictures on the pages of the Bible are images.

Jesus himself was an image, "the image of the invisible God," as described in Colossians 1:15. The Holy Spirit is revealed in the Bible as a dove and as tongues of fire.

"Whoever venerates an image venerates the person portrayed in it. The honor paid to sacred images is a 'respectful veneration,' not the adoration due to God alone."
