WHAT JESUS SAID ABOUT THE EUCHARIST

Most non-Catholics think that the bread and wine at the Catholic Mass are just symbols of Jesus and not truly His body and blood. So what did Jesus say about this?

In the Gospel of John, right after He had multiplied the loaves and fishes, the Jews asked Jesus what sign He could give them so that they might believe in Him. That's one of the biggest questions in the Bible.

So Jesus said to them: "Amen, amen, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave the bread from heaven; my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world...I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

Jesus' words about the bread from heaven were fulfilled at the Last Supper when He took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave to His disciples saying "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." From its earliest days, the Catholic Church has accepted the spoken words of Jesus as true.

"For He spoke, and it came to be, commanded, and it stood in place."


