LETTING CHILDREN GROW UP

There's a problem in family life that may not receive enough attention. It's not recognizing the changes, the growth, that has taken place in members of the family.

Here's an example of how this might happen. Assume there is a large, multi-generational gathering of family members. An uncle finds himself sitting next to a nephew, the son of his older brother. The uncle takes advantage of the opportunity to tell his nephew about all the crazy things his father did in his younger days.

There are two problems here. One is that the old stories might compromise the nephew's respect for his father. The other is that the uncle may not be open to the ways his older brother has changed and matured.

My siblings and most other people I grew up with don't know how much I've changed since my early days. But then I haven't been as curious as I could be about how my brothers, sisters and my own children have changed.

While it's always fun to bring up the old stories from the days of youth, it would be good to ask family members and friends from the past how they would describe the ways they have changed. Or the ways they would like to change.
