### THE NO-CONTACT MOVEMENT

I try to stay current on developments and trends in American family life. So when I came across a reference to the "no contact" movement, I had to check it out.

This growing movement basically involves young adults who have decided to disconnect from family members, especially parents, who they consider to be toxic. They have decided that it would be healthier for them to have a life outside the family and to focus on forming new friendships and peer groups.

Breaking off contact might make sense in situations where there has been clear and harmful abuse. But "experts" who have examined the movement have found that the definition of trauma has been expanded now to include experiences once considered harmless. So causes for disconnection can be political differences, something someone did or said, financial issues, or perceived indifference to emotional issues.

Young adults can be frustrated by perceptions that the parents didn't fully understand and appreciate them. Many of them grew up at a time when they were encouraged to focus on their emotions, either positively or negatively. In a 5th grade classroom, for example, I recently saw the question "How are you feeling today?" below which was an "Emotion Wheel" listing dozens of possible emotions to choose from (one of which was "sensual"). So parents can be blamed for causing or not recognizing and responding to their child's emotional issues.

Even where contact with parents has not been severed, some of today's young adults, for reasons listed above, may have decided to raise their children far differently than the way they themselves were raised.


