### FEELINGS VS. TRUTH

Recent events have focused much of my attention on the tension that exists today between feelings and objective truth. A teenage boy who was friends with some of my grandchildren had taken his life.

I don't know exactly why he did this. But it reminded me what an experienced counselor who had worked primarily with teens told me a few years ago about teenagers and suicide. She said that in her experience most teens who took their own lives just wanted to stop the way they were feeling. They didn't think that much about the permanence of suicide.

The decisions of children to change their gender are almost entirely based on feelings. They believe the change will make them feel better about themselves. The suicide rate is especially high among children who have already made the decision to change their gender. If you change your gender to feel better about yourself and the change doesn't help you feel better, suicide can be the next step in the process of overcoming your negative feelings.

Trent Horn, a Catholic author and father, writes in his book *Made This Way*: "Parents must form a child in objective truth from the youngest years. We don't get to determine what is true based on our feelings; rather, truth exists outside of ourselves, and our job is to seek truth, to find it and to conform our lives and our wills to it."
