#### PARENTS AS PROPHETS

The Bible tells us that every follower of Jesus shares in His role as "priest, prophet and king" So how do we, especially as parents, carry out our responsibilities as prophets in our families? What do prophets do? It's not telling the future. It's not teaching lofty doctrines, but how we fully live the life Jesus offers us. So the prophetic parent admonishes, counsels, encourages, nourishes and models the Christian life to their children.

The responsibilities of the prophet are described in Colossians 3:16: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another." So parents must know the Bible and be familiar with the most basic and important responsibilities required by the Church.

As we know from the Old Testament and from John the Baptist, prophets can often seem extreme. This is especially true in a time like ours where secularism is so prevalent. We must be willing to endure this criticism of our children: "You're the only parents doing this!" It cannot be stressed enough that parents can't just give their children something about faith they can read. When it comes to faith, you parents are the textbook! Your children will learn the most from what they see in you.

"As you know, we treated each one of you as a father treats his children, exhorting and encouraging you and insisting that you conduct yourselves worthy of the God who calls you into His kingdom and glory."
