WELCOMING THE STRANGER

My Jesus told His followers not to share meals with friends but rather to invite the poor and people we don't know to dine with them. Despite the many demands on modern families, we should be encouraged to follow Jesus' instructions. Here are some examples and suggestions. Hosting exchange students from foreign countries is a great family experience. The family not only learns much about the student's life in their home country; it's also very rewarding to share life in the United States with them.

We once offered our home to a teenage boy from El Salvador who was in the United States illegally. He stayed with us while he was pursuing his asylum claim in the immigration court. You could call the immigration people at Catholic Charities and ask them if you could provide a meal or other form of support to a new arrival. In a similar manner, you could call almost any charity and ask if they have someone your family could befriend. You could let them know what kind of outreach your family has in mind. You could be selective about who you allow in your home.

The Chamber of Commerce is aware of visitors to Tulsa from foreign countries. Many of them would rather dine in a local home than eat at a restaurant in a hotel. So the Chamber of Commerce could possibly arrange for your family to host a foreign visitor.
