A CATHOLIC MEDICAL CLINIC

I recently attended the dedication of a Catholic medical clinic started by two friends of mine in upstate New York. It's called Restore Health and Wellness Clinic. Its vision is to cultivate a healing place that reflects the truth, goodness and beauty of God, where every patient is known, understood and cared for. Healing results from the dedication and professionalism of the staff and the presence of the Divine Physician, Jesus Christ.

It has a chapel where each morning the staff gathers to pray for one another, for the patients and for the restoration of everyone involved in the medical profession. In appropriate situations, the staff will pray with patients and their family members.

The clinic offers Restorative Reproductive Medicine, which is more effective, natural, ethical and less expensive than mainstream efforts to help women struggling with infertility, such as in vitro fertilization. RRM, as it's called, addresses the root causes of infertility. In addition to RRM, the clinic provides pediatric care, obstetrics, post-pregnancy support, counseling, massage therapy and what it calls a center for graceful aging. The goal is to restore the whole person and to take as much time as needed to accomplish this.

Maybe something like Restore could find a place in Tulsa and supplement the great work of our two Catholic hospitals.
