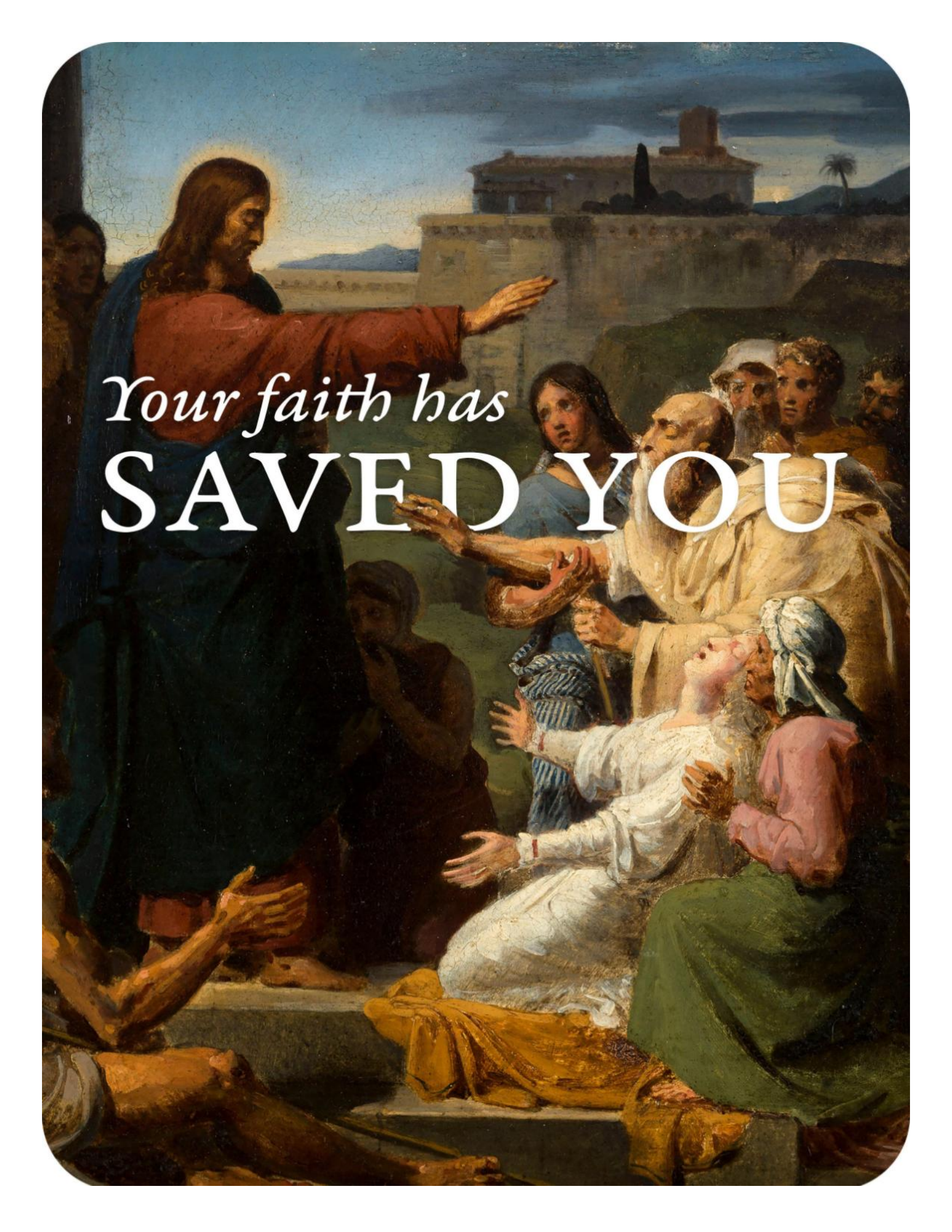

THE INTERVIEW

One of the most popular people I know is my friend, Cyndi. When you meet Cyndi, you are going to be interviewed by her. She will want to know your story, the significant events in your life, what you most value, the principles you live by and what of interest is going on in your life. She has a distinctive charm in the way she asks questions.

I don't have Cyndi's charm, but I've tried to effectively engage people I meet by asking them about themselves. As someone who is responsible in the parish for preparing adults to become Catholic, I always start my first meeting with a candidate by asking them "Who are you? Tell me the significant events in your life, especially regarding issues of faith."

I'm sure I'm not alone in saying that I am in many conversations with people who only talk about themselves and are never going to ask you anything about what's happening in your life. It's a challenge to just go with that and ask questions of them that will at least get you into important aspects of their lives. Interview them.

Jesus sets a great example for this. In Luke 24, a lawyer asks Jesus what he must do to inherit eternal life. Of course, Jesus has the wisdom to give a perfect answer. But instead He says to the lawyer, "What is written in the law? How do you read it?" He interviews him.
