# WHAT'S WRONG; WHAT'S POSSIBLE

Two of the biggest problems for any individual, married couple, family or organization are to see objectively what needs correction and to perceive in a creative, accurate way what is possible.

There's always a challenge caused by the "momentum of what's always been done." People and organizations typically adopt a style of functioning that becomes ingrained and hard to change. We may not be open at all to suggestions about how things could and should be different.

I strongly recommend that married couples, whether they have children in the home or not, have a regular practice of meeting to reflect on their relationship. The meeting should start with prayer for guidance of the Holy Spirit, to help us see what we have trouble seeing. Then the couple should examine the various aspects of married life to determine what and how to improve. For this to work, the couple has to be open, trusting and not defensive.

Our faith life is one of those areas where we can be on automatic pilot. There's a tendency to focus on what we are doing and not on whether we are growing. This can be an institutional problem for the Church. For over six decades, tens of millions of people have left the Catholic Church. It doesn't seem that there is an accurate understanding of why this is happening or what to do about it.


