GOD'S PLAN FOR YOUR MARRIAGE

So, for a married couple, how would you discern God's personal, subjective will for you and your family? Not His objective will for all married couples, but His unique plan just for you?

For example, in 2007, I had a job which my wife and I expected to last until my retirement. Then the Holy Spirit suddenly prompted me to resign that position and search for a new job. We ended up leaving Tulsa, our home for over 30 years, and moving to upstate New York. A friend of mine phoned me to check on how we were doing. He called our leaving Tulsa "counter-intuitive," a nice way of saying "crazy." After five years, my wife sensed that it was time to return to Tulsa, which was confirmed by the Holy Spirit. We came home.

It's hard enough for one person to discern God's personal, subjective will. But, if you're married, who hears God's voice, the husband or the wife? The first step is for both the husband and wife to believe that the Holy Spirit is actively communicating to each of them on a regular basis. Step two is to share these communications with each other and develop a sense of respect, trust and openness for what each of them is experiencing. Step three is praying for the Holy Spirit to guide them in making a decision. This process applies to small issues and big ones. It keeps life exciting.
