WHY YOUNG ADULTS LIKE THE LATIN MASS

For those of us who grew up with the innovations attributed to the Vatican II Council, which include the Mass in English, we don't understand or agree with the many young adults who favor the Mass in Latin. Maybe we should try to know why between 2019 and 2021, there was a 70% increase in attendance in the Traditional Latin Mass, spearheaded by young adults.

Young adults grew up with a rapid increase in technology. They have been bombarded with short, fast-moving bits of information and entertainment. All packaged and sold to them. Many of them are tired of it. They're looking for alternatives, things that are beautiful, mysterious, and fulfilling, with a sense of permanence that they long for.

They grew up in a world of constant change. Now, they don't care so much about the latest trend. They want to know where they came from, something that their education didn't help them understand. The fact that the Latin Mass lasted for 1,400 years helps fill the void.

They don't want to turn the clock back. They're modern people. They want to turn the clock forward, to bring what is rooted firmly in the past into the present. Incense, haunting chants and priests with their backs to the congregation provide a clear, attractive alternative to a generation that has been so incessantly exploited.
