THE WAY

The mission of John the Baptist was to announce that the kingdom of heaven was at hand and to prepare the way of the Lord. So, what was "the way?"

According to John, he was preparing the way for one who would "baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire" and "separate the wheat from the chaff." To those who do accept him, he will give "power to become children of God."

John taught later that the "Word" of God became flesh in this one who was to come, who would bring grace and truth. When Jesus first met John, John exclaimed, "This is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me...he is the Son of God.'"

Peter summarizes the mission of Jesus as follows: He was "commended to you by God with mighty deeds, wonders and signs...You killed him, but God raised him up...He received the promise of the Holy Spirit from the Father and poured it forth." The best evidence of the way then became the earliest Christian community which was on fire from the Holy Spirit.

Jesus made all that He said and did available to us through the Church so that "we might share in His divine nature." Our "Way" then is to experience that divine nature by suffering as He did, sacrificing ourselves for others, "so that when His glory is revealed, we also may rejoice exultantly." 1 Peter 4:13
