THE CHURCH'S TREASURY

There is a concept in the Catholic Church of "the Church's treasury," which is not well understood. This treasury does not refer to the Church's money or the contents of the Vatican museum.

The Catechism defines the Church's treasury as "the infinite value, which can never be exhausted, which Christ's merits have before God." The treasury includes the prayers and good works of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the prayers and good works of the saints, of all those who have followed in the footsteps of Jesus and by His grace have made their lives holy and carried out the mission of the Father entrusted to them.

The graces in the treasury contribute to the salvation of all the members of the Mystical Body of Christ. This means that you and I benefit from the holiness of other members of the Church who have led holy lives. As the Catechism says, in the Body of Christ on earth and in heaven, "The holiness of one profits others." These profits let contrite sinners be more promptly and efficaciously purified of the punishments for sin.

Each of us can contribute to the Church's treasury. The most powerful way to do this is to put our lives on the altar at each Mass we attend and ask the Holy Spirit to accept these gifts and make them into the Body of Christ, to use them in ways that benefit other members of the Church and even those outside the Church.


