THE MAESTRO

A young man approached me recently and asked this question: "I know what God the Father and Jesus do, but what is the role of the Holy Spirit?"

I answered that the Holy Spirit has two main functions: First, He guides us. He prompts us, telling us what to do. Secondly, He gives us the power, the strength, to carry out God's will for us. Through the Holy Spirit, we can live out the meaning and purpose of our lives.

I also mentioned that, most often, when we do what the Holy Spirit directs us to do, we are linked with other people. It's as if the Holy Spirit gives us our piece of a puzzle, and it matches up with the actions of other people. He's the conductor of the orchestra.

Just recently, at a morning Mass here at St. Bernard's, the Holy Spirit prompted me just before Mass to offer it for a couple that had been very active at St. Bernard's for many years but then had moved away. As I came back from Communion and started to kneel down to pray, I saw this couple in line to receive Communion. They were in town to join a pilgrimage from Tulsa to the Holy Land. That's how the Holy Spirit works.




