MID-FISCAL YEAR FINANCIAL UPDATE

The parish's fiscal year runs July through June. Through December, 2025, our Sunday collections were \$1,100,192 vs. our planned Sunday income of \$1,107,288. We are \$79,115 under planned budget for operating expenses. Our net cash flow fiscal year-to-date is \$213,899. Our cash reserves are strong, so the Parish Finance Council authorized an additional pre-payment toward principle on our mortgage for the purchase of Harvest Church of \$500,000. The balance on our original \$2.2 million dollar loan will then stand at \$1.3 million with this and prior payments towards principle that we have made so far in the year that we have owned the property. The Business Office will do another update in July on the balance of the year, but should you have any questions in the meantime, the Business Office is available as well as any Finance Council member. Thank you for your continued generosity toward our parish!

THE SECURITY PROBLEM

We're all tempted by security, to have enough of whatever we need in reserve to cover any eventualities that take place. This drives us to enhance our material and financial resources.

So what does the Bible say? It's reassuring, but only in a way that seems quite challenging. We hear in Scripture that we should "seek first the kingdom of God" and all the earthly things we need will be given us. St. Paul writes to St. Timothy that "if we have food and clothing, we should be content with that."

Shakespeare also joined in recommending an austere focus. Iago, a character in Othello, says that "Poor and content is rich and rich enough." Hecate, a character in MacBeth, proclaims that "Security is mortals' chiefest enemy." Why? Because our desire for security can lead to excesses that lead us away from the path that God calls us to.

In the mind of Jesus, what we have, we hold as stewards, for our own basic needs and to share with those less fortunate. Our true security is in our faith and trust in God. We must work as we can to support ourselves, praying for the Holy Spirit to guide us to follow God's specific, personal will for us and our families.
