MID-FISCAL YEAR FINANCIAL UPDATE

The parish's fiscal year runs July through June. Through December, 2025, our Sunday collections were \$1,100,192 vs. our planned Sunday income of \$1,107,288. We are \$79,115 under planned budget for operating expenses. Our net cash flow fiscal year-to-date is \$213,899. Our cash reserves are strong, so the Parish Finance Council authorized an additional pre-payment toward principle on our mortgage for the purchase of Harvest Church of \$500,000. The balance on our original \$2.2 million dollar loan will then stand at \$1.3 million with this and prior payments towards principle that we have made so far in the year that we have owned the property. The Business Office will do another update in July on the balance of the year, but should you have any questions in the meantime, the Business Office is available as well as any Finance Council member. Thank you for your continued generosity toward our parish!

HOW COMMUNISM IN RUSSIA DIED


Communism in Russia died in 1991. The major players in the process were the Blessed Mother, Pope St. John Paul II, President Ronald Reagan, and Mikhail Gorbachev. Mary appeared in Fatima, Portugal on May 13, 1917. She told 3 young children that if people didn't stop offending God, there would be a new world war and Russia would spread its errors. So, after World War II, communist Russia controlled much of Eastern Europe, including Poland.

Then, in 1978, a Polish cardinal became Pope. John Paul II pushed aggressively for religious freedom in Poland, for which he was shot by an assassin on May 13, 1981, the anniversary of Mary's Fatima appearance. Ronald Reagan began serving as President in 1981. One of his primary goals was to force Communism out of Europe. The key was Poland. If the Communists lost Poland, all of Europe would quickly be freed. Reagan survived being shot by an assassin in March of 1981.

Reagan and John Paul II became close personal friends as they collaborated to free Poland. The Pope shared with Reagan the story of Mary in Fatima. They both felt that God and Mary had saved them from the assassins' bullets. With the help of the Solidarity movement in Poland and Mikhail Gorbachev taking over in Russia, free elections were held in Poland in 1989. Reagan, a devout Protestant, died in 2004. He had arranged for Ave Maria to be sung at his funeral.




