BEING VS. DOING

Living in an achievement-oriented culture, we tend to focus on what a person does more than what a person is. Even when it comes to our faith, we can be tempted to measure our spiritual progress by what we are doing, often using a mathematical process which emphasizes time spent as opposed to interior progress which is not so easily measured. This can be especially tempting during Lent, when we "give up something" or commit to do something that we do not ordinarily give up or do.

As Lent approaches, I suggest putting more emphasis on our being than our doing. Here is a quote from St. Josemaria Escriva that I offer as background for this: "You must realize that God is calling you to serve him in and from the ordinary, secular and civil activities of human life. He waits for us every day, at work, at home, at school. There is something holy, something hidden in the most ordinary situations, which it is up to us to discover...There is no other way, my daughters and sons: either we learn to find our Lord in ordinary, every-day life, or we shall never find him."

So here is a proposed Lenten resolution: At least once a day during Lent, find and be Jesus for another person. Be sensitive and alert to a situation in which you are called to sacrifice yourself for another person. Be a watcher and listener, someone who cares and responds.
