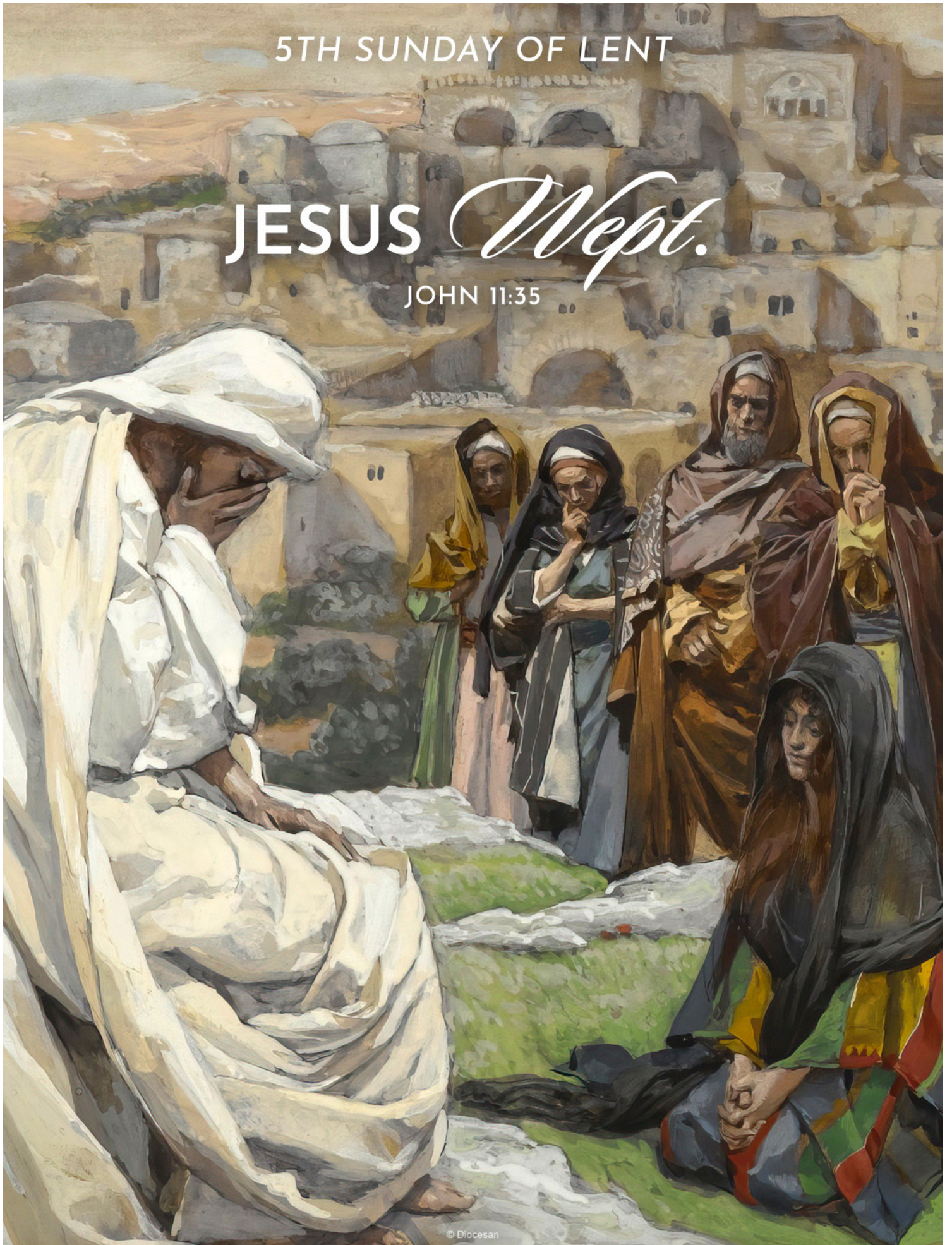

DISCOVERING GOD'S PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE

I love stories about people who have been prompted by a sudden inspiration to do something that dramatically changed their lives. Creative thinking and spontaneity can be inspired by the Holy Spirit.

One of my favorite movies is *Schultze Gets the Blues*. Schultze is a retired factory worker living alone in Germany, playing the accordion in a local band. Late one night, he goes to the refrigerator to get a snack and turns on the radio. He comes across a station featuring the blues, something he's never heard before. He grabs his accordion and begins to play a blues melody. Eventually, he moves to Louisiana to find a blues band he can join.

An even better story involves Barry Levenson, who at one time was a lawyer working for the Wisconsin Dept. of Justice. He was from Massachusetts and a huge Red Sox fan. Devastated by the loss of the Red Sox in the 7th game of the 1986 World Series, he couldn't sleep and went to an all-night grocery store. While looking at ketchups, relishes and other sauces, the thought occurred to him to start a mustard museum. He began collecting mustards.

In 1992, Barry started the National Mustard Museum in Middleton, Wisconsin. Today, the museum has over 6,000 jars of mustard from all 50 states and 70 different countries. It hosts the World-Wide Mustard Competition and the National Mustard Day Festival. Barry's been featured on many TV shows, including Oprah and The Food Network.


