### **FLATTENING AT ST. BERNARD'S**

Most of us have heard or even experienced the outcome of the Vatican II Council, which took place in the early 1960's. One of the outcomes of the Council, not necessarily foreseen by the Council participants, was a flattening of the Church.

This flattening was a function of reducing the hierarchical focus of the Church and emphasizing a greater role for the laity. Another aspect of the flattening was a simplification of Church architecture, reducing or eliminating statues, lowering ceilings, and minimizing stained glass windows.

Our church here at St. Bernard's is a reflection of the flattening process. I'm told by people that were here when the church was designed, that the plan was to have clearly separated sections of the church to accommodate specific lay groups in the parish. So the Knights of Columbus and their families, for example, could all sit in the same section. This is why the choir has its section in a very prominent location, next to the altar. The stained glass was necessary to please the more traditional taste of some parishioners.

The emphasis on flattening in the Church seems to be declining. Younger Catholics and new Catholics are decidedly more traditional. Perhaps the lesson in all this is that we need to be careful about stressing one aspect of the life of the Church at the expense of other important features of our Catholic faith.
