EARLY CHURCH ISSUES

This is the first installment of a series on
helping Catholics know how to have
constructive conversations with non-Catholics
on the issues that are most likely to arise.
This article will deal with misunderstandings
about the early Church.

Many Protestants believe the early Church
was very informal, with Christians meeting in
their homes without any central authority.
While it's true that the elements of the
Church that exist today emerged over time,
there was considerable uniformity and
structure in the early Church.

A First Century document called the Didache
served as a manual for the early Christians. It
addresses baptism, the Lord's Prayer, the
Eucharist, Confession and the ordination of
bishops and deacons. In a letter written in
105, St. Ignatius of Antioch wrote that
without bishops, the presbytery (priests) and
deacons, there is no church. The standards
for a bishop are in the Letter to Titus in the
Bible.

The Bible provides for the authority of Peter
as first pope in Matthew 16, in which Jesus
gives him the "keys to the kingdom." With
respect to a central authority, Acts 15
describes the Council of Jerusalem, at which,
led by Peter, the leaders of the Church
decided what to require of non-Jews who
followed Jesus. According to Acts 16, their
decision was circulated to all the Christians
outside of Jerusalem.

The word "catholic," meaning "universal," was
first associated with the Church by St.
Ignatius of Antioch. And it was at Antioch
that the followers of Jesus were first called
"Christians."
