Our Lady of the Rosary

Pope St. Pius V established this feast in 1573. The purpose was to thank God for the victory of Christians over the Turks at Lepanto—a victory attributed to the praying of the rosary. Clement XI extended the feast to the universal Church in 1716.

The development of the rosary has a long history. First, a practice developed of praying 150 Our Fathers in imitation of the 150 Psalms. Then there was a parallel practice of praying 150 Hail Marys. Soon a mystery of Jesus' life was attached to each Hail Mary. Though Mary's giving the rosary to St. Dominic is recognized as unhistorical, the development of this prayer form owes much to the followers of St. Dominic. One of them, Alan de la Roche, was known as "the apostle of the rosary." He founded the first Confraternity of the Rosary in the 15th century. In the 16th century the rosary was developed to its present form—with the 15 mysteries (joyful, sorrowful and glorious). In 2002, Pope John Paul II added **the Mysteries of Light to this devotion.**

The purpose of the rosary is to help us meditate on the great mysteries of our salvation. Pius XII called it a compendium of the gospel. The main focus is on Jesus—his birth, life, death and resurrection. The Our Fathers remind us that Jesus' Father is the initiator of salvation. The Hail Marys remind us to join with Mary in contemplating these mysteries. They also make us aware that Mary was and is intimately joined with her Son in all the mysteries of his earthly and heavenly existence. "***The Glory be***" remind us that the purpose of all life is the glory of the Trinity.

The rosary appeals to many. It is simple. The constant repetition of words helps create an atmosphere in which to contemplate the mysteries of God. We sense that Jesus and Mary are with us in the joys and sorrows of life. We grow in hope that God will bring us to share in the glory of Jesus and Mary forever.

A favorite prayer of eminent Catholics, St. Mother Teresa was always seen reciting the rosary. Daniel O'Connor, the "Father of the Nation" of Ireland recited the rosary in his private room before each session of the parliament and no wonder why Ireland is called "The Land of the Rosary." The famous proponent of the rosary, Fr. Peyton, challenges us: "set apart ten minutes for rosary at home, you will make your home a heaven of peace." The great scientist William Ampere in his old age inspired and converted Frederick Osanam (the founder of St. Vincent de Paul Society) by his daily recital of the rosary at a grotto. The last words of Louise Pasteur to his nurse before his death far away from his home were: "tell my wife that I died reciting the rosary."

Nuestra Señora del Rosario

El Papa San Pío V estableció este homenaje en 1573. El propósito era agradecer a Dios por la victoria de los cristianos sobre los turcos en Lepanto, una victoria atribuida a la oración del rosario. Clemente XI extendió la conmemoración a la Iglesia universal en 1716.

La evolución del rosario tiene una larga historia. Primero, se instituyó una práctica de orar 150 Nuestros Padres imitando los 150 Salmos. Luego hubo una práctica similar de rezar 150 Avemarías. Pronto se unió un misterio de la vida de Jesús a cada Ave María. Y aun el hecho de que María le confiere el rosario a Santo Domingo es poco histórico, el impulso de esta forma de oración debe mucho a los seguidores de Santo Domingo. Uno de ellos, Alan de la Roche, era conocido como "el apóstol del rosario". Fundó la primera Cofradía del Rosario en el siglo XV. En el siglo XVI, el rosario floreció a su forma actual, con los 15 misterios (gozos, dolorosos y gloriosos). En 2002, el Papa San Juan Pablo II agregó los Misterios de Luz a esta devoción.

El propósito del rosario es ayudarnos a meditar sobre los grandes misterios de nuestra salvación. Pío XII lo llamó un compendio del evangelio. El enfoque principal está en Jesús: su nacimiento, vida, muerte y resurrección. Nuestros Padres nos recuerdan que el Padre de Jesús es el iniciador de la salvación. Las Avemarías nos recuerdan unirnos a María para contemplar estos misterios. También nos hacen saber que María estuvo y está íntimamente unida a su Hijo en todos los misterios de su existencia terrenal y celestial. "La Gloria" nos recuerda que el propósito de toda la vida es la glorificación de la Trinidad.

El rosario atrae a muchos. Es simple; la repetición constante de palabras ayuda a crear una atmósfera en la que se contemplan los misterios de Dios. Sentimos que Jesús y María están con nosotros en las alegrías y penas de la vida. Crecemos con la esperanza que Dios nos llevará a compartir la gloria de Jesús y María eternamente.

El rosario es una oración favorita de los eminentes católicos. La madre Santa Teresa de Calcutta siempre se vio rezando el rosario. Daniel O'Connor, el "Padre de la Nación" de Irlanda recitó el rosario en su habitación privada antes de cada sesión del parlamento y no es de extrañar por qué Irlanda se llama "La Tierra del Rosario". El famoso defensor del rosario, el Padre Peyton, nos reta: "Aparten diez minutos para el rosario en casa, y harán de su hogar un paraíso de paz". El gran científico William Ampere en su vejez inspiró y convirtió a Frederick Osanam (el fundador de la Sociedad de San Vicente de Paul) por su recital diario del rosario en una gruta. Las últimas palabras de Louise Pasteur a su enfermera antes de su muerte lejos de su hogar fueron: "Dile a mi esposa que morí recitando el rosario".
