Living the Gospel: What Really Matters

[Readings: Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23, Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11, Luke 12:13-21]



This Sunday, Jesus invites us to rethink what we treasure. A man in the Gospel asks Jesus to divide an inheritance—but Jesus redirects the conversation. Life is not about *what we own, but who we are becoming*. In a world obsessed with more—more stuff, more likes, more control—Jesus offers a better path: *Be rich toward God*.

Here are some ways to live out today’s Gospel message this week:

- **Before spending, pause and pray.** Ask: “Is this helping me live more simply, love more deeply, and trust more fully?”
- **Clean out one drawer or closet.** Let go of what no longer serves you—and consider donating to someone in need.
- **Reconnect.** Call a relative, send a kind note, or have an unhurried conversation. Relationships are what last.
- **Give a little extra.** Whether it’s time, attention, or support—practice generosity without expecting a return.
- **Limit screen time.** Instead, spend 15 minutes reflecting with Scripture or simply sitting with God in silence.
- **Remember your true worth.** You are more than your work, your bank account, or your social status. You are a beloved child of God.

Jesus reminds us today: We can fill our barns but still have empty hearts. This week, choose what fills your soul.

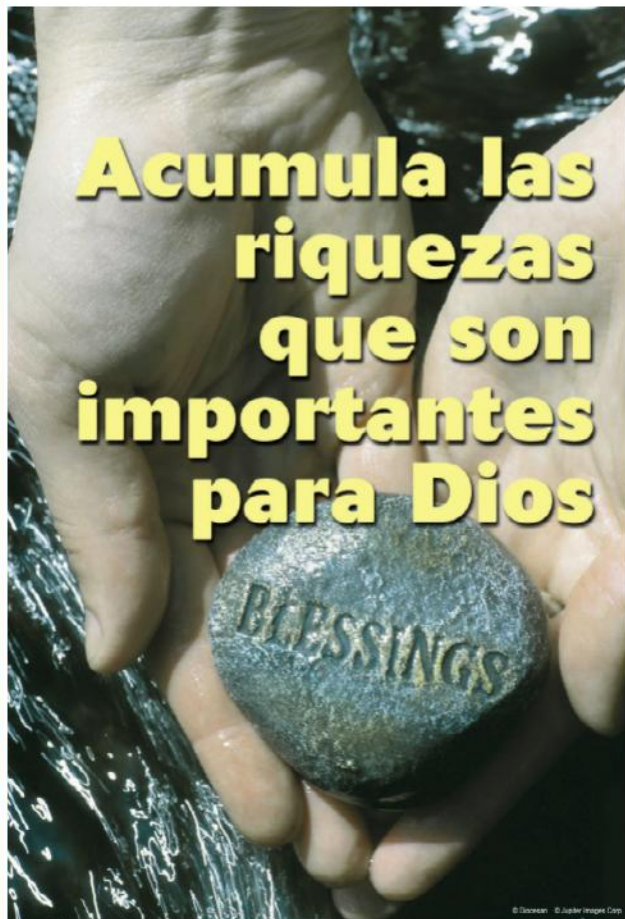

Vivir el Evangelio: Lo que Realmente Importa

(Lecturas: Eclesiastés (Cohélet) 1, 2; 2, 21-23, Colosenses 3, 1-5. 9-11, Lucas 12, 13-21)



Este domingo, Jesús nos invita a volver a repensar lo que valoramos. Un hombre en el Evangelio le pide a Jesús que divida una herencia, pero Jesús redirige la conversación. La vida no se trata de lo que poseemos, sino de en quién nos estamos convirtiendo. En un mundo obsesionado con tener más—más cosas, más “me gusta”, más control—Jesús nos ofrece un camino mejor: Sé rico a los ojos de Dios.

Aquí tienes algunas maneras de vivir el mensaje del Evangelio esta semana:

- **Antes de gastar, haz una pausa y ora.** Pregunta: “¿Esto me ayuda a vivir con más sencillez, amar con más profundidad y confiar con más plenitud?”
- **Limpia un cajón o un armario.** Deshazte de lo que ya no necesitas y considera donarlo a alguien que lo necesite.
- **Reconéctate.** Llama a un familiar, envía una nota amable o ten una conversación sin prisa. Las relaciones son lo que perdura.
- **Da un poco más.** Ya sea tiempo, atención o apoyo—practica la generosidad sin esperar nada a cambio.
- **Limita el tiempo frente a las pantallas.** En su lugar, dedica 15 minutos a reflexionar con la Escritura o simplemente a estar en silencio con Dios.
- **Recuerda tu verdadero valor.** Eres más que tu trabajo, tu cuenta bancaria o tu estatus social. Eres un hijo amado de Dios.

Jesús nos recuerda hoy: Podemos llenar nuestros graneros, pero seguir teniendo el corazón vacío. Esta semana, elige lo que te llena el alma.
