

Hating Father and Mother

St. Thomas More was the Lord Chancellor, when Henry VIII was the King of England. More, with a wife and children, was a successful lawyer, a great linguist and a renowned spiritual and political writer. His book, Utopia, has become a classic. More refused to take an oath supporting the Act of Succession, which (a) recognized the offspring of the self-divorced Henry and his second wife Anne Boleyn as the heir to the throne; **(b)** declared Henry's first marriage with Catherine as null and void, and so (c) repudiated the Pope (who had given Henry a dispensation for that first marriage). Consequently, More was imprisoned in the Tower of London in the year 1534. Thomas More could not, with any honesty, approve Henry's second marriage to Anne, and he could not acknowledge the King as the supreme head of the Church of England. His family implored him - for his sake and theirs - to take the oath. More's beloved daughter, Margaret, took an oath to persuade him to do so, in order that the family might visit him in prison. With More's wife and son-in-law, Margaret tried hard, but Thomas refused. He spent fifteen lonely months imprisoned in the Tower of London – in poor health, isolated from the other prisoners, deprived of his beloved books; not even paper and pen were given to him. Thomas More was convicted of treason, sentenced to death and, on July 6th, 1535, he was beheaded. -- On mounting the scaffold, Thomas More proclaimed

that he was "the king's good servant but God's first." St. Thomas More paid the price for his discipleship by loving God more than his wife, children, nay, even his life.

There are several of you who are committed in your lives. Our commitment to Truth of the gospel and being people of compassion. Compassion is not compassionate if it lacks truth, and the truth is not true if it is not presented with the virtues by which our Lord wants them brought forth.

Odiando a Padre y Madre

Santo Tomás Moro fue Lord Canciller cuando Enrique VIII era rey de Inglaterra. Moro, con esposa e hijos, fue un exitoso abogado, un gran lingüista y un reconocido escritor espiritual y político. Su libro, Utopía, se ha convertido en un clásico. Moro se negó a prestar juramento de apoyo al Acta de Sucesión, que (a) reconocía a la descendencia del divorciado Enrique y su segunda esposa, Ana Bolena, como herederos al trono; (b) declaraba nulo el primer matrimonio de Enrique con Catalina, y (c) repudiaba al Papa (quien le había otorgado a Enrique una dispensa para ese primer matrimonio). En consecuencia, Moro fue encarcelado en la Torre de Londres en el año 1534. Tomás Moro no podía, con honestidad, aprobar el segundo matrimonio de Enrique con Ana, ni reconocer al Rey como cabeza suprema de la Iglesia de Inglaterra. Su familia le imploró, por su bien y el de ellos, que prestara juramento. La querida hija de Moro, Margarita, juró persuadirlo para que lo hiciera y así poder visitarlo en prisión. Junto con la esposa y el yerno de Moro, Margarita se esforzó, pero Tomás se negó. Pasó quince meses solitarios encarcelado en la Torre de Londres, con mala salud, aislado de los demás prisioneros, privado de sus preciados libros; ni siguiera le dieron papel ni pluma. Tomás Moro fue declarado culpable de traición, condenado a muerte y, el 6 de julio de 1535, decapitado. Al subir al cadalso, Tomás Moro proclamó que era «el buen siervo del rey, pero primero de Dios». Santo Tomás Moro pagó el precio de su discipulado amando a Dios más que a su esposa, sus hijos e incluso a su vida.

Varios de ustedes están comprometidos con sus vidas. Nuestro compromiso es con la verdad del Evangelio y con ser personas compasivas. La compasión no es compasiva si carece de verdad, y la verdad no es verdadera si no se presenta con las virtudes que nuestro Señor desea que se manifiesten.


