A MESSAGE FROM FR. JAY NUTHULAPATI UN MENSAJE DEL P. JAY NUTHULAPATI

Violence Against Humanity (Part 1 of 2)

The Sacredness of Human Life. From the very beginning, the Church has proclaimed that every human person is created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:27). Because of this, each life possesses an inviolable dignity that must be respected and protected. Any act of violence against humanity—whether war, terrorism, genocide, torture, human trafficking, or systemic oppression—is a direct assault on God’s creation and a grave sin against both justice and charity.

The Church’s Teaching:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us: “Respect for and development of human life requires peace. Peace is not merely the absence of war, and it is not limited to maintaining a balance of powers between adversaries. Peace is the tranquility of order” (CCC 2304). Violence, in all its forms, disrupts this God-given order and replaces it with fear, hatred, and destruction.

The U.S. Bishops, in their pastoral message *Confronting a Culture of Violence*, wrote: “Our families are torn by violence. Our communities are destroyed by violence. Our faith is tested by violence. We have an obligation to respond.” Violence is not only physical but also verbal, structural, and cultural. It can be found in our homes, our streets, our media, and even in our hearts. *(to be continued next week)*

Violencia contra la Humanidad (Parte 1 de 2)

La sacralidad de la vida humana. Desde sus inicios, la Iglesia ha proclamado que toda persona humana es creada a imagen y semejanza de Dios (Génesis 1:27). Por ello, cada vida posee una dignidad inviolable que debe ser respetada y protegida. Cualquier acto de violencia contra la humanidad —ya sea guerra, terrorismo, genocidio, tortura, trata de personas u opresión sistémica— constituye un ataque directo a la creación de Dios y un grave pecado contra la justicia y la caridad.

La enseñanza de la Iglesia:

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos recuerda: «El respeto y el desarrollo de la vida humana exigen la paz. La paz no es solo la ausencia de guerra ni se limita a mantener un equilibrio de poderes entre adversarios. La paz es la tranquilidad del orden» (CIC 2304). La violencia, en todas sus formas, perturba este orden divino y lo reemplaza con miedo, odio y destrucción.

Los obispos estadounidenses, en su mensaje pastoral «Enfrentando una cultura de violencia», escribieron: «Nuestras familias están desgarradas por la violencia. Nuestras comunidades están destruidas por la violencia. Nuestra fe se pone a prueba por la violencia. Tenemos la obligación de responder». La violencia no es solo física, sino también verbal, estructural y cultural. Se encuentra en nuestros hogares, nuestras calles, nuestros medios de comunicación e incluso en nuestros corazones. *(Continuará la próxima semana)*
