Children are unique individuals who are eager to learn, and we should value their differences, needs, learning styles, experiences and interests. Extensive research has shown that children learn through active involvement and play, constructing, demonstrating and representing their knowledge in a wide variety of ways. The social components of learning stresses the importance of interactions, cooperation and collaboration. Early childhood educators recognize that learning opportunities must be age and individually appropriate. A developmentally appropriate program recognizes that

- Children construct their own knowledge.
- Learning activities must actively engage children.
- Language develops best in a social context.
- Families and communities must be more fully involved as partners with schools.
- Appropriate assessment strengthens learning and teaching.
- Positive social environments contribute to learning.
- Inclusive programs expand opportunities for all children.
- Honoring children's cultural backgrounds helps them maintain and build respect and honor the culture of others.
