This year's project is FEBRUARY 26 thru MARCH 8, 2026 - PLEASE MARK YOUR CALENDARS!!!!

This year 25 local Publix stores will be selling St. Clement “Make Your Own” advanced shortcake tickets for \$5.50, a savings of \$.50.

It is our hope and prayer that you, your family, and friends will once again respond by giving generously of your time and talent as this has become a great tradition at St. Clement. For children and teens, this is a great opportunity to earn service hours.

“Strawberry Time” is a wonderful time of sharing talent, seeing old friends, and making new ones. JOIN US!!

UNIFORMS AND TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED FOR BOOTH WORKERS ***Everyone Wear Comfortable Shoes!!*

White button-down shirt or blouse with collar required for all booth workers. (We have a good supply of white shirts, ask if needed)

Male festival booth workers are required to wear dark long pants. Hats & aprons will be provided.

Ladies arrive in pants, shorts, or leggings. A skirt, apron, and doily head covering will be provided.

BOOTH RESPONSIBILITIES February 26 thru March 8 Smiling is REQUIRED for ALL POSITIONS
Standing is required while in booth, breaks will be provided, no chairs in guest booth area.
Entry into festival and food tickets and drinks will be provided.

AGE REQUIREMENT

A volunteer worker at the booth must be 16 years or older.

Those 16, 17, 18 year olds in high school and still living at home must work with a parent.

Volunteers 16 years old must show the shift supervisor proof of being born before March 2, 2007, festival rules, and no exceptions!

EARLY MORNING BOOTH SETUP - Setup at 6:00 AM every day. Involves preparing the booth tables, moving ice, filling the bowls with berries, begin making whip cream, etc. Volunteers can do this before going to work or school in the morning.

Lifting required.

SUPERVISOR - Looks after booth volunteers and ensures everything runs smoothly. Familiar with all booth positions, keeps Project Coordinator updated on any issues. (Must be trained)

CROWD CONTROL - Greets guests. Ensures that guests get in proper lines and stay out of the flow of traffic. **Standing, Walking, Holding Sign Required.** ****Requires being out in the sun at times.**

CASHIER - Sells tickets at booth during Festival. **Speed and efficiency required.**

TICKET TAKERS - Allows “advanced ticket” guests entry, collects tickets, and directs guests to shortest serving lines. **Standing Required.**

SHORTCAKE GIRLS - Hands out bowl with cake or biscuit to guest. **Standing Required.**

BERRY GIRLS - Place berry topper on guest’s shortcake. Remind each guest to take a napkin and a spoon. **Standing Required.**

LIGHT DUTY FOOD HANDLERS - Keep the serving line stocked with bowls, napkins, spoons, etc. (Can be Male or Female). **Standing/Walking Required.**

HEAVY DUTY FOOD HANDLERS - Keep the serving lines stocked with cakes & biscuits, strawberries and whipped cream. Ensure floor and serving lines are always clean. **A LOT OF WALKING & LIFTING REQUIRED UP TO 50 LBS.**

STICKER PERSONS - Applies sticker as guests exits booth area. **Standing Required. NO chairs allowed in booth area.**

SHORTCAKE STACKER - Stacks cakes and biscuits on trays in the booth kitchen. **Speed, efficiency and some lifting required.**

CREAM WHIPPERS - Makes the whipped cream for the shortcakes in the booth kitchen. **Speed, efficiency, lifting required.**

KITCHEN HELPER - Keeps all utensils, buckets, etc. rinsed/washed. Help in kitchen as needed. **Some lifting Required.**

RELIEF PERSONS - Relieves positions as needed. Needs to fully understand the positions they relieve. **Standing Required.**

COFFEE PERSON - Makes coffee. Keeps sugar, cream, stirrers supplied. Sells water and soft drinks.

CUSTOMER SERVICE - Clean tables and floor in eating area of any spills. Pick up trash left on tables. Wipe tables. Assist guests if needed. **Standing/Walking Required.**

HALL RESPONSIBILITIES (Feb 26 thru March 8) (LUNCH WILL BE PROVIDED FOR ALL HALL WORKERS).

BERRY HULLING - May arrive as early as 7:30 am until completed. Stem berries, prepare berries for booth. Clean up work area when finished and setup for the next day.

BERRY PRODUCTION LINE - Work on production line that washes, slices and sugars berries. **Lifting Required.**

CAKES DEPARTMENT - May arrive between 8:00 and 8:30 am until completed. Prepare cakes and repack for use at the booth. Clean area and setup for next day. **Standing Required.**

UNIFORM COMMITTEE - Repair and replace existing uniforms. Daily wash, dry and fold uniforms for use by booth workers. Assist booth workers getting dressed. **Standing Required.**

HEAVY DUTY HALL WORKERS - Capable of lifting up to 50 lbs. We need 4-5 men in the hall from 6:30 am until about 1:00 pm. Distribute flats of fresh berries to tables, load trucks, gather hulled berries for processing, wash and dry topper berries. **Standing, Walking, Lifting Required.**

NIGHTLY BUCKET WASHING - Good opportunity for children and families to work together every evening around 6:00 pm till completed. **No age requirement. Meal provided. (MORNING BUCKET WASHERS NEEDED FEBRUARY 28).** **Standing, Walking, Lifting Required.**
