What does an Edge Core Member Do?

An Edge Core member helps on Monday or Wednesday Nights from 6pm-7:45pm. He or she is given a binder at the beginning of the semester with all of the Edge Nights (curriculum) in it. An Edge night typically flows as follows: Opening prayer as a large group, an opening game/activity related to the topic of the night, return to the main space for a proclaim talk (main teaching of the night led each week by a different Core Member), small group time where each grade/group goes to a different room to discuss the night (this is why we need lots of help), a prayerful send off for the night (another activity, rosary, lectio divina, Eucharistic Adoration fills this last part of the night). At least a week before the Edge Night Core Members are given the modified outline of the night.

What does a Life Teen Core member do and what is the time requirement?

A Life Teen Core member helps two Sundays a month for 4 hours each Sunday. A Life Teen Core member does many of the same activities as an Edge Core Member but the format and time requirements differ. Life Teen Core members must arrive an hour before Mass to help with set-up. After Mass, Life Teen Core helps with the Pot Luck after Mass and greeting the teens. Life Teen will follow the pot luck for 1 hour and 30 mins. Life Teen follows the same structure as the Edge Nights: Gather, Proclaim, Break, and Send. After clean-up the Life Teen Core stays and discusses how Life Teen went and briefly talks about the next Life Teen before "praying out". Time after clean up will not be more than a half hour time requirement.
