The Four Mysteries of the Rosary

Joyful: Annunciation (Lk 1:26-38), Visitation (Lk 1:39-56), Nativity (Lk 2:1-21), Presentation (Lk 2:22-38), finding Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:41-52) (traditionally prayed Mondays, Saturday, and also Advent and Christmas Sundays)

Luminous: Baptism in the River Jordan (Mt 3:13-16), Wedding Feast at Cana (Jn 2:1-11), Proclamation of the Kingdom (Mk 1:14-15), Transfiguration (Mt 17:1-9), Institution of the Eucharist (Mt 26, Mk 14, Lk 22, Jn 6:25) (traditionally prayed Thursdays)

Sorrowful: Agony in the Garden (Mt 26:36-56), Scourging at the Pillar (Mt 27:26), Crowning of Thorns (Mt 27:27-31), Carrying the Cross (Mt 27:32), Crucifixion (Mt 27:33-56) (traditionally prayed Tuesdays, Fridays, and also Lenten Sundays)

Glorious: Resurrection (Jn 20:1-29), Ascension (Lk 24:36-53), Descent of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-41), Assumption, Coronation (Rev 12) (traditionally prayed Wednesdays and also Sundays during Easter and Ordinary Time)



Other Traditional Prayers

Trust in God

Leave the past to the mercy of God,
Seek in the present the will of God
Leave the future to the providence of God.



Prayer to the Holy Spirit (often used before devotions/study)

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations, Through Christ Our Lord, Amen.

Prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel (often following mass/devotions)

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.
