Green = **Flock & Edge**: **grades 1-8** (most weeks, Wednesday evenings, 6:00-7:15 PM)

- Pink = First Confession/First Communion (special days (child + parent(s) or grandparent(s)) for those receiving these Sacraments)
 - <u>Saturday, January 6, 2024, 9:00 AM 12:00 PM</u>: First Confession Retreat. Each child + at least one parent or grandparent attend together for a morning of prayer, crafts, learning, and practicing for our upcoming First Confession!
 - <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 24</u>, <u>2024</u>, <u>6:00 7:15 PM</u>: First Confession! Each child attends with their parent(s)/grandparent(s), and the whole family is encouraged to come too and celebrate Confession together!
 - <u>Saturday, April 13, 2024, 9:00 AM 12:00 PM</u>: First Communion Retreat. Each child + at least one parent or grandparent attend together for a morning of prayer, crafts, learning, and practicing for our upcoming First Communion!
 - *Saturday, April 20, 2024, 4:00 PM **OR** *Sunday, April 21, 2024, 10:30 AM. First Communion Day! ***Families will vote*** in September/early October on **which day they prefer and we'll go with the majority**'s preference. In either case, please arrive 45 minutes before Mass begins so we can all be settled, calm, prayerful, and ready to go when Holy Mass begins.
- Red = Cor: grades 9-11 (twice a month, Sunday evenings 6:00-8:00 PM).
 - *Sunday, September 10, 2023: Family Launch Night: 9th-11th graders and their parent(s) attend together.
 - o Includes potluck supper, time for questions, discussion, and family Eucharistic Adoration!
 - o If you have children in grades 1-8 also, you may choose which of the two launch nights your family attends.
 - Other red-shaded calendar days are "normal" High School Cor, 6:00-8:00 PM, twice per month.
 - Some dates have two colors shaded in. The **LIGHT RED** is for Confirmation (juniors or seniors) and the **RED** is for Cor. Cor is the name for our "regular" 9-11th grade faith formation
 - Just a reminder: we only have 15 Cor sessions (including the Family Launch Night) for the whole year. Each one is important. Please look at your family's and teen's calendar ahead of time and communicate with coaches, employers, etc that 9th-11th graders are unavailable for these 15 evenings.
 - Finally, please note the time is different than last year. We meet 6:00 PM til 8:00 PM, which is a half-hour earlier than previous years. This change is due to the limited number of evening Cor sessions, the Diocese requirements regarding instructional hours, and the need to have more time for "going deeper" in our learning, discussion/small group, prayer time, and social time.
