

Procedures for Resuming the Public Celebration of Mass in Phase II

1. If you are feeling ill or have a fever, cough, or sneezing, please stay home. Per the Diocese's guidelines, those 65 or older, those in a high-risk category, or those in the same household as someone in a high-risk category are strongly encouraged to stay home. You are certainly allowed to attend if you choose, knowing you are at greater risk for infection.
2. Please use the restroom in your home before you arrive.
3. Please arrive in plenty of time for Mass.
4. When you arrive, please join a line by either the South or West entrance. While in line, a volunteer will take your temperature with a no-contact thermometer, provide hand sanitizer, and provide a mask for those don't have one.
5. Single-use song sheets will be available at each entrance with the music for the Mass. They should be discarded after Mass.
6. An usher will direct you into the Church. To keep enough space between households, some pews are roped off or taped off and not to be used. Please only sit in the designated spots and keep six feet between households.
7. Mass will proceed as usual. In accordance with Diocesan guidelines, we will not share the Sign of Peace during this Phase II transition.
8. For Holy Communion, Father Andy will come to each section starting with the Eastern-most section. (see diagram enclosed in this mailing). Ushers will help direct everyone.
9. After Mass, please proceed directly to your vehicle.
