The volunteer will not place any pressure on you to commit a specific amount of financial support, nor will they know of your decision. You will receive a cross made from the pews of the South Campus for your participation.*

The volunteer will return your unopened pledge envelope to Fr. Kevin. As with any financial commitment you offer to Christ Our Light, your decision will only be known by Fr. Kevin and Teresa Callison - Parish Administrator, who enters that information into parish records and fully understands the importance of maintaining absolute confidentiality.
