



Commitments Needed to Reach Our \$6,150,000 Capital Campaign Goal

- ❖ Our campaign will be well organized, dignified, respectful and confidential. No one will be told whether to or what to contribute. The process will be an invitation for your financial support.
- ❖ Every household is blessed differently with a unique capacity to respond. Therefore, it will be up to each to determine what they can sacrifice over the next three years to move our building forward.
- ❖ All gifts are welcome and will be appreciated. However, we are inviting you to consider the largest commitment you have ever offered to Christ Our Light Catholic Parish or any charity.
- ❖ The chart invites you to consider a 10% down payment at the time you offer your commitment. The remaining 90% of your commitment can be contributed weekly, monthly, or annually over the next 36 months (four tax years) from May 1, 2022, through April 30, 2025.
- ❖ As you determine your financial commitment, consider the possibility of combining your decision with your children's and grandchildren's to offer a larger, multi-generation family commitment.

How Will You Choose to Let God Speak Through Your Decision?

This chart represents the variety of gifts that we need to reach our financial goal. It is a flexible instrument, and the relationship between each level can be adjusted. If the top gifts cannot be secured, then the emphasis will need to shift to other levels and the number of gifts needed at each lower level must increase accordingly.

How Will You be Invited to Offer Your Financial Commitment?

The 10 Easy Steps

1. On or about March 20, each household will receive a brochure in the mail with all the information you will need to reach a decision on your participation/financial support. The information will include a “sample” commitment card printed in the brochure.
2. When the volunteer visitor telephones you, please establish a convenient time to meet for a brief 5-10 minute non-pressured and confidential visit. The volunteer worker will not tell you whether to or what you should contribute. No discussion needs to take place.
3. The 5–10-minute visit between you and the volunteer visitor could be in your home, after Mass at church, before or after religious education classes, at the church in a confidential area, or a local coffee shop/restaurant – anywhere that you both feel comfortable.
4. You will want to determine your campaign commitment before the volunteer arrives for the visit you both will arrange. If you never offered a pledge or contribution during the previous campaign, now is a wonderful opportunity to offer your significant support!
5. Remember that your commitment should be above and beyond your regular weekly contributions for the church operating budget, and your religious education fees.
6. Simply record your commitment on the “sample” card printed in the brochure and you are ready for the volunteer visitor to meet you.
7. When the volunteer visitor arrives at the location you agree to meet, please welcome them in a true spirit of Christian openness. The volunteer will carry your personalized commitment card and a confidential security return envelope, with a printed screen on the inside to prevent viewing information written on the commitment card.
8. Once you have reached your decision and are ready to offer your commitment, the volunteer will ask you to fill out the information (privately and confidentially) on the card. After you transfer your decision from the “sample” in the brochure to the actual card, you will then place the card in the security envelope (only your name and address will remain visible) and seal the envelope. This will ensure your decision is confidential and will not be known by the volunteer visitor.
9. You will return the completed commitment card (already sealed in the envelope) to the volunteer who will deliver it to Father Kevin through the reporting process.
10. This process should remove any anxiety or pressure between you and the volunteer visitor.
