If your child tells you that someone showed them XXX pictures on a computer or tv....call 9-1-1.

If your child tells you an adult touched them sexually and the adult told your child, "don't tell anyone"...call 9-1-1.

If someone sends your child any sexual pictures on their cell phone, I-Pad, etc...call 9-1-1.
