SOME NOTES FROM FR. JOE:

1) This week I will be in ROME, ITALY. I am going to meet with officials from the Vatican to discuss the pilgrimage to Rome in June 2018. IF there is an emergency or a funeral, please contact the Catholic Office of the Deaf immediately. Fr. Roberto is in town this week.

2) The newly blessed HOLY WATER. When I was young, if there was a storm or terrible weather, or people in our home were sick, my father would take the Holy Water and sprinkle us with it. He would say, “God bless and protect us. In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.” You can do the same in your family.

3) BIBLE READINGS, especially in the weeks after Easter. We list the daily readings from the Bible each week. During this “Easter time” in the Church, we have beautiful readings, especially from the ACTS OF THE APOSTLES. The ACTS tell us about the earliest days of the Church, after the Resurrection and Ascension of Jesus to heaven.
