## **SOME NOTES FROM FR. JOE:**

\* We begin reading two VERY important books of the Bible. St. Paul wrote his Second (2) Letter to the Corinthians when he (St. Paul) was older. He writes about believing in the promises of Jesus, but also realizing that we all become sick, weak, and die. This Letter is very much about having FAITH no matter what happens in your life.

MATTHEW 5:1-12 is the beginning of chapters 5-7 in St. Matthew. These chapters teach us how we are to live as true followers of Jesus Christ.

RECENTLY, at St. Francis Borgia parish, the Chicago Police Department had a workshop about preventing burglary of your home. There were seven former burglars (6 men and one woman). All of them had stolen from many homes. They had all served time in jail. They told people how to prevent burglaries.

- ❖ Homeowners get lazy. They leave a garage door or a back door open/unlocked. LOCK your doors, even if you are only gone for a few minutes. The average burglar spends 5 minutes or less robbing a home.
- ❖ If a burglar sees an outdoor camera on your home, the burglar will go somewhere else. Thieves are afraid of cameras, because the police will look at films of who went in or came out of the house.
- ❖ Do NOT leave cell phones, I-Pads, anything electronic, credit cards out on tables. Why? Because thieves look for these first. If you will be gone for a day or several days, lock ALL valuables up.
- ❖ Going on Vacation? Make sure someone picks up your mail and also any newspapers or flyers on your porch.
