SOME NOTES from FR. JOE:

1) During Cardinal George's funeral Mass, there was a beautiful song "O DIVINE REDEEMER". The words of the song are a beautiful prayer we can offer for those who have died, especially our parents, spouses, but also a prayer for ourselves:

"O Divine Redeemer, do not turn away from me, receive me though I am unworthy. Lord, my distress, pay attention to my cry! Answer me from Your throne. Hurry, Lord, to help me. Show me Your pity because I am suffering terribly. Do not let the sword of vengeance destroy me, even though You, Lord, have a right to be angry with me. Shield me in danger, Oh do not ignore me! To You alone, Lord, I call. O Divine Redeemer! I pray, Lord grant me pardon, and remember not, remember not my sins! Forgive me, O Divine Redeemer! Darkness gathers around my soul. I am afraid. I cry to You. Lord, come to help me. Hurry, Lord, hurry to help me! See me crying for help. Save me Lord because You are merciful. Lord, come to save me.

O my God, save me in the day of punishment. Protect me from death.
