3) The next few weeks, summer vacations begin. Children are OUT of school and ON our streets. SLOW DOWN especially near PARKS, SPORTS' FIELDS, POOLS, etc. We have to look out for these children.

6) The State of Illinois is cutting back monies for MEDICAID, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES. REMEMBER:

- ❖ If you get a letter from Medicaid or the State of Illinois that says REDETERMINATION, do NOT throw this letter away. If you do not respond to a REDETERMINATION letter, the State can cut your health insurance from MEDICAID. Talk to someone about your rights.
- ❖ If your health insurance is cut, or you do not have health insurance, AND you get sick, call 9-1-1! Why? Because if the Paramedics take you to an ER (Emergency Room), the doctors must treat you. If you are deaf and get sick at home, dial 9-1-1 and leave the phone off the hook.
