6) Our situation with sign-language interpreters: The Catholic Office of the Deaf tries to provide sign-language interpreter for all CATHOLIC services. We especially try to offer interpreters for a Funeral Mass or Cemetery service. However, we face two problems:

a) Often, we get a call the day or night before the service. The funeral home says, “we need an interpreter tomorrow at 9am!”

b) MON-FRI during the day, many interpreters are working for video-relay or in schools, and they are unable to reply immediately. Sometimes, our Office manager, Ms. Colleen Curry, spends HOURS trying to locate an interpreter.

SO.....if you need an interpreter for a Funeral, Baptism, wedding, please contact the Catholic Office of the Deaf as soon as you have the information. IF its urgent on the weekend, TEXT me (Fr. Joe) at 312-685-7899. We try to do our best to serve our families. Please help us do this work.
