The Catholic Church believes that the soul of a person who dies can go to one of three places. The first is heaven, when a person who dies is in a state of perfect grace and communion with God. Second is hell, where those who died in a state of mortal sin are naturally condemned by their choice. Third is purgatory, which is thought to be where most people, free of mortal sin, but still in a state of lesser sin, go. The Catholic Church believes that through the prayers of the faithful on Earth, the dead are cleansed of their sins so they may enter into heaven."
