If you would like to become a Minister of Care and be able to bring Holy Communion to our homebound or in hospital parishioners, please inform Fr. Roberto TODAY! The new ministry of care training at St. Benedict in Niles starts THIS Wednesday, September 27th; at Presence St. Benedict Home in Niles. The 5 consecutive classes will be from 7-9pm.

WARNING: West Nile Disease. This disease is from mosquitoes. Things to do:
1) Empty all water from outside: kids' pools, bird baths, anything holding water. This is where mosquitoes hatch their eggs.
2) Outside in the early morning or evening/dusk...make sure you wear mosquito repellent.

Why do we have the HAWTHORNE RACE? The CATHOLIC OFFICE of the DEAF provides services for deaf and hard of hearing persons and their families all over the Chicago metropolitan area. The Archdiocese of Chicago provides HALF (50%) of the Office's budget. Fr. Roberto has to raise the OTHER 50%. The horse race gives us a profit each year of \$30,000+. This is a big chunk of the budget! Without the Hawthorne Event, the Catholic Office of the deaf will have to stop providing sign-language interpreters for individuals and families, stop sending out mailings and announcements about deaf events.
