- *We start reading, 8/25, St. Paul's FIRST LETTER to the CORINTHIANS. CORINTH was a city of Greece. It was a city with a lot of business. It was a city with many pagans (people who believed in many gods.) It also was a place of violence, prostitution, and other sins.
- St. Paul lived there for a year and a half, and built up a strong Christian community. After he left, there were problems in that community of believers. So, St. Paul wrote a letter (Epistle) to the community, his FIRST LETTER to the CORINTHIANS.

In many ways, CHICAGO is similar to CORITH. We have many of the same problems. So, reading St. Paul, think about how his words also teach us living in 2016 in our own city and country.
