!!! The Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows (the Blessed Mother). The Catholic Church teaches she had seven (7) sorrows: Presentation of Jesus in the Temple; escape into Egypt; Jesus lost in Jerusalem; Mary seeing Jesus carry His cross; the Crucifixion; taking Jesus’ body from the cross and giving it to Mary; Jesus’ burial.
