School Lunch Menu

January 14th - December 18th

Monday:

Chicken nuggets, whipped potatoes, brown gravy, green beans, pears, hot roll, and milk.

Tuesday:

Ham & cheese wrap, vegetarian beans, broccoli/cauliflower salad, strawberries, and milk.

Wednesday:

Chili/cheese, pickle spear, corn, peaches, cinnamon roll, and milk.

Thursday:

Baked chicken, rice & gravy, carrots, black-eyed peas, blueberries, and milk.

Friday:

Hamburger or cheeseburger, pickle slices, french fries, ketchup, mixed green salad, ranch, mixed berry cup, and milk.

Note: Lunches are \$2.75 each. Milk is \$.50. If your child eats in the cafeteria daily the weekly lunch bill should be approximately \$13.75.

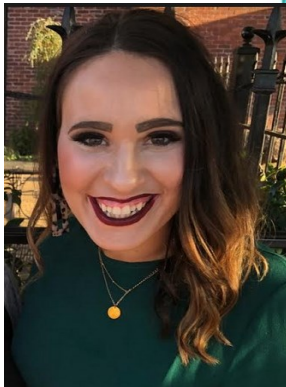
Welcome

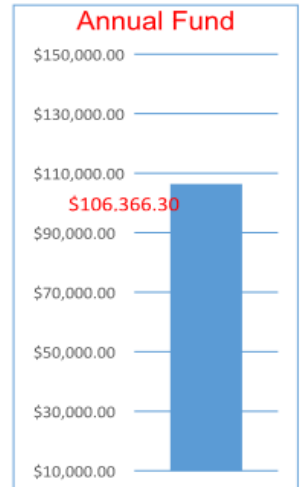
