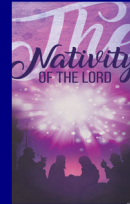

What does Christmas look like to you when you close your eyes? What are the first things that come to mind? Is it your home, decorated with bright colorful lights and Christmas displays? Is it a place, perhaps a favorite spot that you visit during the season? Do you picture Christmas of your childhood?

What does Christmas smell like to you? Do you think of cookies baking in the oven? Is there a scented candle or incense that brings your mind back to Christmas? Is it the smell of your fresh cut pine tree?

What does Christmas feel like to you? Do you get washed over with warmth when thinking of the holiday season? Does it cause goose bumps when thinking about how excited someone will be when they open a gift from you?

For most of us, we have a very deep and personal connection with Christmas. Our different senses pick up unique experiences and contribute to creating such a powerful connection with this time of year. You will hear "*Jesus is the Reason for the Season*" and "*Remember what Christmas is all about*", and "*Keep the Christ in Christmas*". Nothing wrong with any of those sayings, but that is all that they are, just sayings. It is when you make the effort to decide on including the religious aspect (the most important) of Christmas that those sayings have some weight.

Nobody's Christmas experience, or story is the same. We all have different connections, different memories, different hopes, different joys, and yes different sorrows. We all can think of someone (or many) that we wish could be celebrating with us this year, but instead are in Heaven.

Part of the "*Good News*" is that really those loved ones **are here** celebrating with us. When you close your eyes and think of that person, especially around Christmas, if you get washed over with emotion, that is them connecting with your spirit. It is okay to acknowledge them and say hello. That is prayer. It connects us with those in Heaven.

The last week before Christmas break, the students at Assumption Academy spent time enjoying the season. The entire school was, and still is decorated for Christmas. Lit Christmas trees greet the students each day at the two entrances. The faculty have woven festive activities into the academic lessons. The students have a contagious Christmas spirit. There is nothing like the pure joy of interacting with children during this season.

My wish to you is that no matter what your Christmas looks like this year, that you take a few moments to connect with the joy of others. It can be as simple as sharing a smile to a stranger, or praying for a loved one. No matter how you choose to celebrate, just know that the entire Assumption community is celebrating *with* you.
