It is well known that a celebration is good only to the degree that it is prepared for. This is especially true in the spiritual realm of life which, in our business, we often place on the back burner, as it were. *Please remember to prepare spiritually for the coming of Christ at Christmas.* Notice in the Mass schedule and in the Calendar Events the extra times offered for the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Also, please notice that the Mass schedule for Christmas Day, next Sunday, differs from other Sundays in that: 1.) there are 2 vigil Masses, 4:00 and 6:00pm and a Mass at Midnight, 12:00am and 2.) there is **no 6:00pm Mass** on Christmas or New Year's Day.

The Angel Scholarship Fund allows participants to contribute funds that will be used to provide tuition assistance for students to attend our Catholic schools (donors may direct their dollars to any Catholic school in the Diocese of Cleveland), and will in return receive a 100% Ohio income tax credit of up to \$750 against their 2022 state tax liability. In other words, the state of Ohio allows you to "spend" some of the state income taxes that must be paid anyway to provide tuition assistance for students seeking an education in our Catholic schools.
