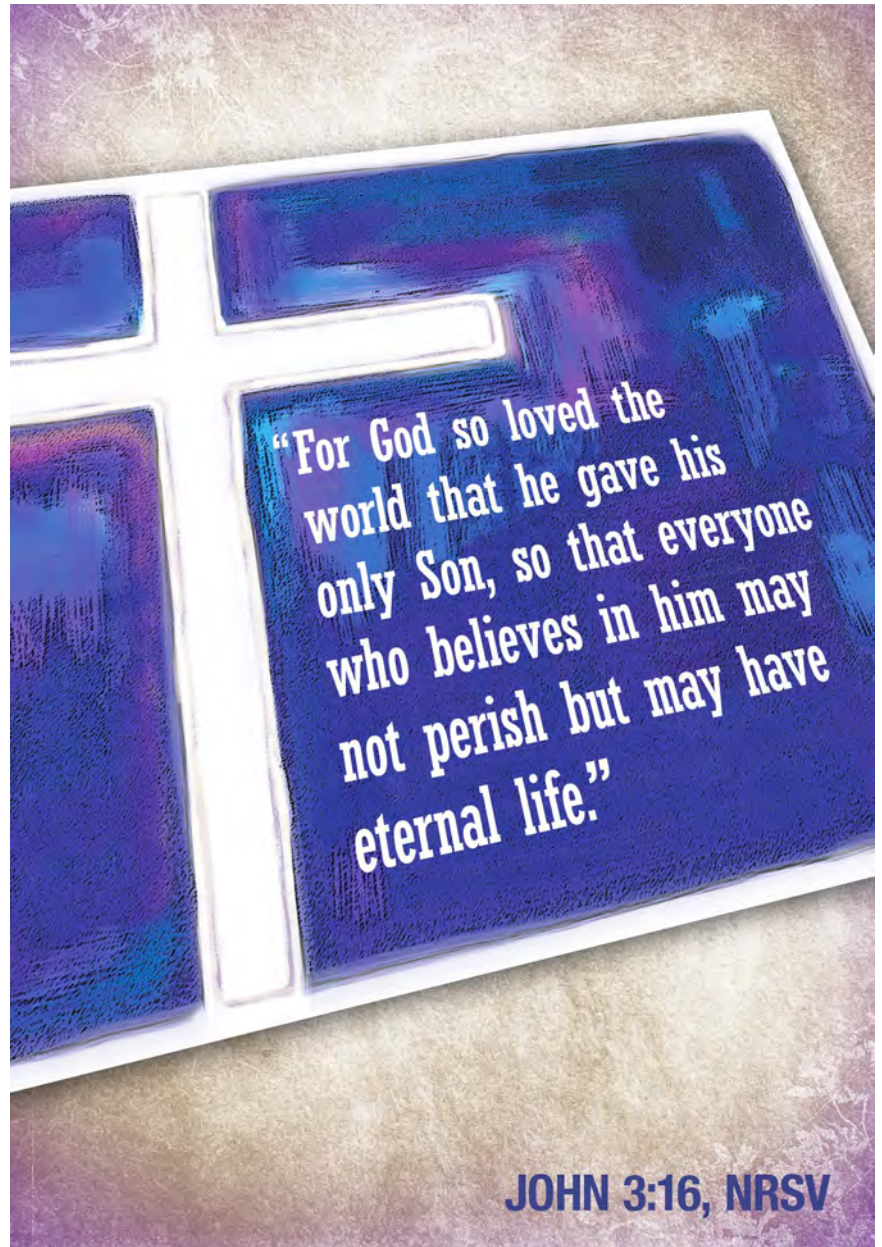

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER SCHMECKEL

This Sunday is the Fourth Sunday of Lent, traditionally called **Laetare Sunday**. You will notice that the priest's vestments are rose/pink colored. This lighter and brighter color reminds us that we are about halfway through Lent, our time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. It also marks a shift in our readings and the tone of our celebrations. At weekend Mass, the readings shift from focusing on our own conversion to focusing more on Jesus as He prepares to go to Calvary to be crucified.



This halfway mark in the Season of Lent gives us an opportunity to examine our habits of prayer, fasting and almsgiving that we took up at the start of Lent. We might ask: Am I remaining faithful to those Lenten resolutions? Did I have unreasonable expectations? Do I need to make some adjustments to those resolutions? Do I need to restart those habits that I committed to?

Laetare Sunday gets its name from the Entrance Antiphon of the Mass in Latin: *Laetare, Ierusalem, et conventum facite, omnes qui diligetis eam...* (The Entrance Antiphon is scriptural verse sung, usually with a Psalm, at the beginning of Mass. We often use a hymn in its place.) In English the full meaning is: "*Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.*" This comes from Isaiah 66:10-11. It reminds us to rejoice, even during Lent, and to be glad, even when we have sorrow or loss in our lives.

In the Gospel this Sunday we hear the reason that we can be glad – even when we find the Cross in our lives. Jesus says one of the most famous lines in all of the Gospels: "*For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.*" (John 3:16) Whenever we feel overwhelmed or bogged down by challenges or difficulties, we ought to remember that God sent his own Son, Jesus, into the world to suffer and die because **God has loved the world, and that includes each and every one of us.**

Through prayer, study, and reflection, we can come to know that **we are loved by God**. This changes everything in our lives. This gives purpose and meaning to trials and suffering. This gives the encouragement to love members of our families even when it is most difficult. At times it also demands that we make changes in our lives and turn away from sin and bad habits. This is not just a warm and fuzzy sentiment, but something that must determine all that we do and say because – **WE ARE LOVED BY GOD.**

PRIEST PLACEMENT PROCESS

"To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven"
Ecclesiastics 3:1

At the January 27/28 Masses, Fr. Schmeckel announced he will be leaving Blessed Trinity and St. John Evangelist Parishes this June. The Archbishop's office informed Fr. Schmeckel that another parish in the Archdiocese needs a priest with his leadership experience. Although this was unexpected, Fr. Schmeckel is working with the Archbishop to support the Archdiocese. As we pray for Fr. Schmeckel and his search for a new parish, we also pray for our parish communities as we progress through the Pastoral transition process. In keeping with Catholic Church procedures, the next pastor will be assigned to our parishes by the Archbishop. Prior to that assignment by the Archbishop, a process occurs which includes prayerful discernment and consultation with the Priest Placement Board.

Blessed Trinity and St. John Evangelist Pastoral Councils are working together with the Archdiocese of Milwaukee to determine the best leader to replace Fr. Schmeckel.

On Wednesday evening, February 28, the Pastoral Councils, Finance Councils and Staff of both parishes met with Brenda Cline, who is a member of the Priest Placement Board and the Manager of Priest and Lay Ecclesial Personnel and Placement Office for the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Brenda conducted a session where she shared the Archdiocesan statistics on the number of priests who are retiring, the number of priests who need reassignment and the number of parish openings. Those in attendance used a questionnaire to generate additional ideas for our parish profiles.

Blessed Trinity and St. John Evangelist Pastoral Transition Teams are being formed. Our Parish Profile was written and submitted in March 2022 and will be updated with guidance from Brenda Cline. This profile includes information such as our historical statistics on membership, ministry activity, special attributes of our parish as well as long-range goals and plans. Our profile will be emailed to Brenda Cline the week of March 25 and shared with the Priest Placement Board.

In the next few weeks, the priests make requests to the Priest Placement Board for a possible parish assignment and the Priest Placement Board begins the process of dialoging with the priests about their assignment choices. Following these discussions, the Priest Placement Board will make its recommendations to the Archbishop who will then discern the best leader for our parishes.

In May, priests will receive their new appointments from the Archbishop. We will then be informed of our parishes' new pastor. Full transition is expected to be complete by the third week of June, and new assignments are officially effective on the first of July. Please pray for those involved in the placement process and for the priests who will be transitioning.

Plans are in the works for a farewell social for Fr. Schmeckel in June. A welcome event for the new pastor will be planned as well. Please watch the bulletin for details on both events.

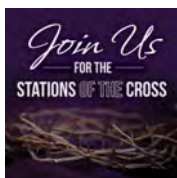

ENRICH YOUR LENTEN JOURNEY

LENTEN OBSERVANCE

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. For this reason:

a) Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent; b) Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Hence, on those days they may eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.
