**What Is Eucharistic Adoration?**

Eucharistic Adoration is quiet time spent in prayer with Jesus present in the Eucharist. A consecrated host is placed in the center of a monstrance on an altar and there are individuals who commit to a specific weekly prayer hour in the chapel visiting and spending time with the Real Presence of Jesus. **It is an expression of love for Jesus, who loves us so much that He never wants to leave us. He says: "Behold I am with you always." Mt 28:20**



Pope John Paul II described adoration as "**looking upon the face of Christ.**" When you come for Eucharistic Adoration and see the Sacred Host in the monstrance, this is not a symbol of Jesus, but the reality of Jesus himself. **The same Jesus who was born in Bethlehem two thousand years ago, the same Jesus who died on the cross for our sins, and the same Jesus who rose again on Easter Sunday is really truly, bodily, personally present in the chapel.**

**Next Week's Gospel: John 2:13-25**  
Third Sunday of Lent – March 7, 2021

**Gospel Reflection**

Watch out for Jesus in today's Gospel! He has come up to the Temple at the feast of Passover and he is very angry about what he sees there. So he brandishes a whip to drive the money-changers and sacrificial animals out of the temple. "Stop making my Father's house a marketplace," he says with authority. His disciples attribute his emotional outburst to zeal, or intense passion, for the house of God.

When the Jews ask him for a sign of his authority, Jesus speaks of the temple of his body. He prophesies that if they destroy this temple, he will raise it up in three days. They do not understand that he is speaking of his Crucifixion and Resurrection.

**Discussion Questions for Gospel**

Does the fiery anger of Jesus surprise you? Why or why not? Are there times when it is right to express justified anger? Explain. How do you think believers should show love and respect for God's house?
