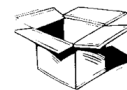

**Gospel Reflection**

If you and a partner were sent to several different schools to talk about your faith, what worries might you have? When Jesus sent his apostles out two by two, he warned them that some people would not welcome them. He insisted that they take to the road without food or money, trusting in God and the goodness of their hosts. If people would not provide for them or listen to their message, they were to move on to the next place.

But those who accepted the apostles were rewarded. The sick were healed, the possessed were freed of demons, and sinners were reconciled.

**Discussion Questions for Gospel**

Jesus sent his apostles forth as missionaries without packs, but not without training. They had learned from his word and example what they were to teach. What kinds of training have you been given at home, at school, or in the community? How have you shared the training you received? If you were asked to teach younger children a faith lesson, what kinds of materials might you want to take with you?

Fr. Maus comes to us after serving for six years as pastor for St. Jerome in Mohall, St. James in Sherwood and St. John in Lansford. Originally from the Golva, ND, area, Fr. Maus attended power plant school at Bismarck State College, played football and earned an agriculture degree at Dickinson State University, and worked as a farmer and rancher with his father. After feeling called to the priesthood, Fr. Maus attended Cardinal Muench Seminary in Fargo for three years, then Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri, for four years. He was ordained at the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck on June 12, 2014.
