

THE RESURRECTION-Our Father... First Mystery
(John 20:1-17)

1. "Now on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene came early to the tomb, while it was still dark, and she saw the stone taken away from the tomb." Hail Mary...
2. "She ran therefore and came to Simon Peter, and the other disciple, and said to them, 'They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him.'" Hail Mary...
3. "Peter therefore went out, and the other disciple, and they went to the tomb." Hail Mary...
4. "...the other disciple ran on before, and came first to the tomb...stooping down he saw the linen clothes lying there, yet did not enter." Hail Mary...
5. "Simon Peter therefore came following him, and he went into the tomb..." Hail Mary...
6. "...he saw the linen clothes lying there, and the handkerchief which had been about his head, not lying with the linen clothes, but folded in a place by itself." Hail Mary...
7. "Then the other disciple also went in, and he saw and believed;" Hail Mary...
8. "But Mary was standing outside weeping, and beheld Jesus standing there, and she did not know that it was Jesus..." Hail Mary...
9. "Woman, why art thou weeping, whom dost thou seek?..." "Sir, if thou hast removed him, tell me where thou hast laid him and I will take him away." Hail Mary...
10. "Jesus said to her, 'Mary!' Turning, she said to him, 'Rabboni!' (that is to say, Master)." Hail Mary...Gloria

ASCENSION OF JESUS-Our Father... Second Mystery
Acts 1:1ff

1. "In the former book, O The-oph-i-lus, I spoke of all that Jesus did and taught from the beginning until the day on which he was taken up,..." Hail Mary...
2. "To (the apostles) also he showed himself alive after his passion by many proofs,..." Hail Mary...
3. "And while eating with them, he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father,..." Hail Mary...
4. "... (the promise) of which you have heard,' (Jesus) said, by my mouth,..." Hail Mary...
5. "...for John indeed baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days hence." Hail Mary...
6. "They therefore who had come together began to ask him, saying, 'Lord, wilt thou at this time restore the kingdom of Israel?'" Hail Mary...
7. "But he said to them, 'It is not for you to know the times or dates which the Father has fixed by his own authority;...' Hail Mary..."
8. "...but you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you,..." Hail Mary...
9. "...and you shall be witnesses for me in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and even to the very ends of the earth." Hail Mary...
10. "And when he had said this, he was lifted up before their eyes, and a cloud took him out of their sight." Hail Mary... Gloria

tion of the body and life everlasting. Amen.


THE MEMORARE

(Luke 1:46-55)

6. “He has shown might with his arm, he has scattered the proud in the conceit of their heart.” Hail Mary...

7. “He has put down the mighty from their thrones, and has exalted the lowly.” Hail Mary...

8. “He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty.” Hail Mary...

9. “He has given help to Israel, his servant, mindful of his mercy...” Hail Mary...

10. “...even as he spoke to our fathers—to Abraham and his children forever.” Hail Mary... Gloria

DESCENT OF HOLY SPIRIT-Our Father... Third Mystery

1. “And when the days of Pentecost were drawing to a close, they were all together in one place.” Hail Mary...

2. “And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a violent wind blowing, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.” Hail Mary...

3. “And there appeared to them parted tongues as of fire which settled upon each of them.” Hail Mary...

4. “And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in foreign tongues, even as the Holy Spirit prompted them to speak.” Hail Mary...

5. “Now there were staying in Jerusalem devout Jews from every nation under heaven.” Hail Mary...

6. “And when the sound was heard, the multitude gathered and were bewildered in mind, because each heard them speaking in his own language.” Hail Mary...

7. “Behold, are not all these that are speaking Galileans? And how have we heard each his own language in which he was born?...” Hail Mary...

8. “But Peter, standing up with the Eleven, lifted up his voice and spoke out to them: ‘Men of Judea and all you who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give ear to my words.’” Hail Mary...

9. “‘...this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: ‘And it shall come to pass in the last days, says the Lord, that I shall pour forth my Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams...’” Hail Mary

10. “Now they who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.” Hail Mary... Gloria (Acts 2:1ff, Acts 2:41)
